- To propose systems, templates, SOPs and methodologies that shall ensure EASE OF DOING BUSINESS in issuance and approvals of the SRO specific incentives and make the mechanism transparent.
- 3. To quantify fiscal benefits provided by the GOP against each issued IOR and its benefits to the domestic economy against value additions.
- 4. To make the system transparent.
- 5. To recommend a Value addition policy for the new ADP 2021-2026
